Over the last 12 months we have witnessed a significant maturing of the social investment market with an explosion of quality businesses led by outstanding entrepreneurs. Two years ago we had a dozen opportunities with no more than 3 investment ready at any one time. We now have over 40 with at least 10 ready to put your money to good use.

In this issue we are focusing on the environment. Below are a list of opportunities to invest in that should hearten you to see that somebody is doing something about the state of our planet amongst the doom and gloom that is reported. But first allow me to quote a challenge from the FT's Associate Editor, Simon Targett in a piece he wrote this week in the first of their three part feature on climate change:

"...on this issue [climate change], as perhaps with no other, politicians do not only have to answer to their electorates, and business leaders do not only have to answer to their shareholders, they also have to answer to their loved ones, to their own kith and kin. 'What did you do to save the world?' To say 'Nothing' is no kind of answer."

They are a start up after £200k as a debenture offering a % of profits for the next 10 years. Expected IRR potentially 20% plus.

International Businesses

Experienced Investors only* A solar powered LED lighting system to replace the dangerous and CO2 contributing Kerosene lamps that are widespread across sub-Saharan Africa and Asia. They are after £500k offering an IRR of 20%.

Funds

ALL Triodos Renewables www.triodos.co.uk – a fund dedicated to establishing and running wind farms and tidal operations in the UK. This is their second round of funding hoping to raise £8.5m offering an IRR of 10%

ALL Quadris www.quadris.co.uk – investing in the reforestation of large tracts of land in Brazil that have been reclaimed from cattle and soya production. They invest in a mix of sustainable Teak plantations (the first to be receive FSC certification) and protect indigenous conservation areas. They are an open ended listed fund with over £11m under management with expected IRR of 10%
